INVESTOR FORUM PUBLISHES PATHWAY TO LONG-TERM VALUE SURVEY RESULTS

(London, 15th December 2017)

The Investor Forum is pleased to publish the results of a survey undertaken in response to the recommendations of the BankingFutures Pathway to Long-Term Value project.

Four clear signals emerge from the survey of institutional investors:

- A strong signal that non-financial information is very important to understand long-term value
- An important challenge for Banks regarding the quality and consistency of that information
- A clear message that banks should reduce the emphasis on Quarterly reporting
- An appetite to focus communication through a 2 page summary of long-term value drivers

The Investor Forum's involvement in BankingFutures over the last three years, together with this survey, has provided a practical opportunity for banks, investors and other stakeholders to work together to explore how to enhance trust in banks and increase the focus on creating sustainable long-term value.

"Our survey has identified clear evidence that investors believe non-financial measures provide crucial insights which can help assess how banks can create long-term value.

We encourage bank management teams to create a framework to communicate these key value drivers to enhance the dialogue, and focus, on long-term sustainable value creation rather than short-term trends in quarterly earnings."
